At Fishburn Community Football Club (FCFC), we strive to create a positive and supportive environment for all our young players. To ensure the best experience for everyone involved, we ask that parents and guardians adhere to the following code of conduct:

Respect and Sportsmanship

- 1. **Positive Support**: Encourage all players, not just your own child. Applaud effort, good play, and sportsmanship by both teams.
- 2. **Respect Officials**: Accept decisions made by referees and officials without argument. Understand that they are an essential part of the game and doing their best to ensure fair play.
- 3. **Respect Coaches**: Trust the coaches' decisions regarding team selection, tactics, and player development. Their aim is to benefit the team and individual players.

Behaviour and Attitude

- 4. **Positive Role Model**: Demonstrate respectful behaviour at all times. Avoid negative comments, abusive language, and aggressive behaviour.
- 5. **Constructive Feedback**: Offer constructive criticism rather than negative feedback. Focus on what players did well and how they can improve.
- 6. **Encouraging Effort**: Emphasise the importance of effort and enjoyment over winning. Celebrate personal and team progress.

Communication

- 7. **Open Dialogue**: Communicate any concerns or issues directly with the coaches or club officials in a respectful manner.
- 8. **Supportive Community**: Promote a welcoming and inclusive environment for all families and participants. Avoid gossip and negative discussions about players, coaches, or other parents.

Commitment and Responsibility

- 9. **Punctuality**: Ensure your child attends practices, games, and team events on time. Notify coaches in advance if your child is unable to attend.
- 10. **Preparedness**: Make sure your child is properly equipped and ready to participate in all activities (e.g., appropriate footwear, water bottle, and any required gear).
